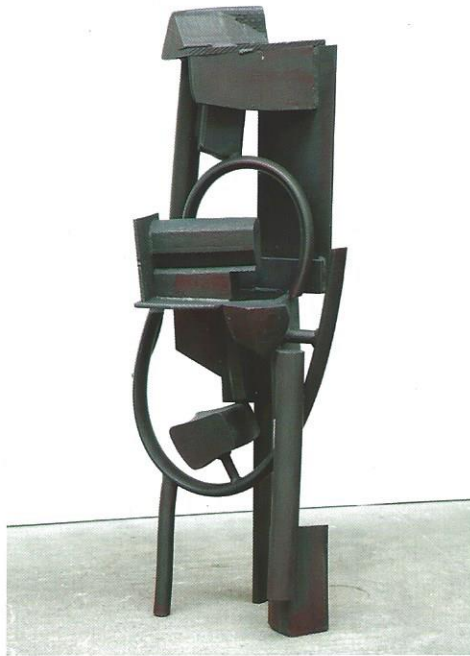

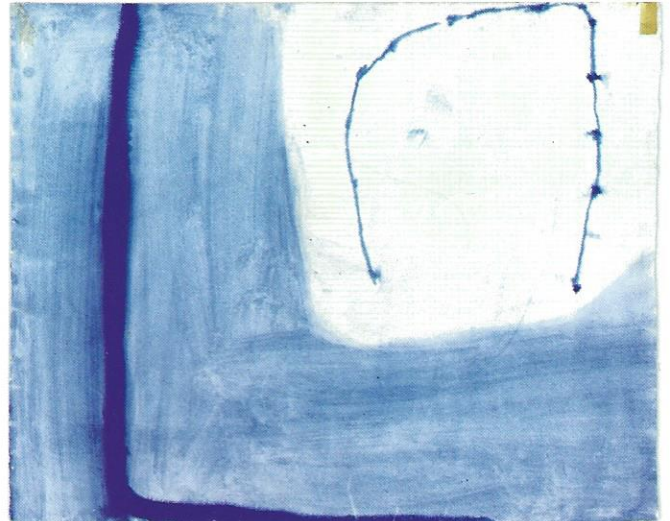
Janus IV, by Jeff Lowe

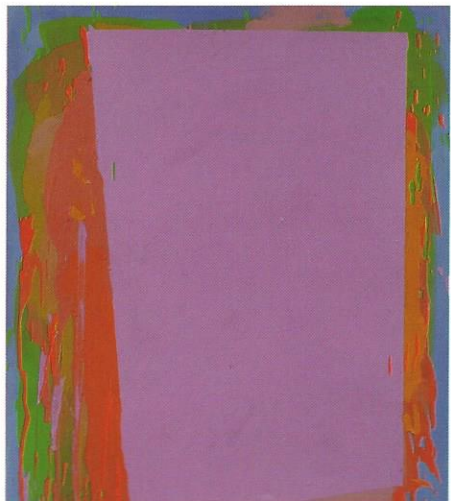


Blue harbour, by Sir Terry Frost (1915–2003). 1989.
